Some people think they can get away with this on a weekly basis but I can tell you this, the team officials from our club who have been acting in an unacceptable behaviour have been noted by the Junior League and an eye will be kept on them in future games. Not only do they show a lack of control and set a bad example to their players but they are also giving the Chester Hill Hornets a bad name.
